INTRODUCTION

The Harihara Mardaraj Distance Education Centre will admit candidates to the First Year of the THREE YEAR DEGREE COURSES (General and Honours) under Berhampur University to be taught through the Distance Education Mode in accordance with the Syllabus and Regulations of Berhampur University as prescribed from time to time. This is aimed at providing higher education to persons of all age and sex, particularly to in-service persons, to persons otherwise handicapped and persons residing in the remote areas. It is also proposed to provide a viable alternative mode of education to students, who cannot devote whole time required for a student in college owing to some social or other difficulty.

CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

The courses will have a span of three academic sessions commencing from 2016 – 2017. Any person, who has passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Council of Higher Secondary Education, Odisha or any other qualifying examination recognized by the Academic Council of CHSE, Odisha and Berhampur University as equivalent thereto may be admitted into the **First Year of the Bachelor of Arts or Commerce (General or Honours) or Bachelor of Science (Honours) Courses** and the admission shall be subject to Regulations of Berhampur University. A candidate admitted for the period 2016 - 2019 is to appear the examination at the end of each academic session. The candidates desirous to take admission into the first year of the course of a particular stream may give their option in the application itself whether they intend to appear at the General or Honours Examination. In case of change from Honours to General there will be no refund of money to the student concerned. If a candidate intends to change over from General to Honours he can do so on application for permission from Distance Education Centre on payment of the differential amount of **Rs.1000/-** and such other fees as prescribed from time to time within thirty days from the last date of admission.

FOR ATTENTION OF ALL APPLICANTS

The applicants before applying to any of the Three Year Degree (+ 3) Honours/Pass courses in Arts/Commerce/Science (Hons.) are advised to carefully go through the Prospectus and visit the University Website (www.buodisha.edu.in) to know about the profile of the University. They are also advised to visit the University Campus, Bhanja Bihar and the Harihara Mardraj Distance Education Centre, if they so desire and see for themselves the available infrastructure and other facilities. If satisfied, they may apply to any of the courses as per their eligibility. Once admitted, making any unreasonable demand thereafter shall not be entertained and it shall be treated as an act of indiscipline.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: The Prospectus and Application Form for admission into the Three Year Degree (+3) Honours/Pass in Arts/Commerce/Science (Hons.) Courses can be downloaded from the Berhampur University website (<u>www.buodisha.edu.in</u>) in PDF form during <u>01.07.2016</u> (Friday) to <u>09.08.2016</u> (Tuesday).

The candidates seeking admission to these Courses have to send the following by Registered Post/Speed Post to the Director, Harihara Mardaraj Distance Education Centre, Berhampur University, Berhampur-760 007, Ganjam, Odisha:

- a) The downloaded prescribed Application Form duly filled in their own handwriting and complete in all respects;
- b) The Processing-cum-Application fee Rs.300/- (Rupees three hundred) only for admission into the TDC courses for the session 2016-17 is payable as specified in the Procedures given in **Schedule C.**
- c) Attested copies of the certificates, Mark Lists and documents listed in Schedule B.

The Harihara Mardaraj Distance Education Centre will allot Index Number to each candidate, whose valid applications are received before the last date (that is <u>09.08.2016</u> (Tuesday) and upload the same in the University website (<u>www.buodisha.edu.in</u>) by <u>25.08.2016</u> (Thursday).  - A link to the SB collect will also be available in the University website <u>www.buodisha.edu.in</u>, which will take the candidate directly to the SB collect page for his/her online transaction.
 - On the SB collect page accept the disclaimer clause and click on "Proceed".
 - Select the State of Corporate/institution as 'Odisha'.
 - Select type of Corporate/Institution as "Educational Institutions" and click on 'Go'.
 - Now select Education Instruction Name as 'BERHAMPUR UNIVERSITY' and click on 'Submit'.
 - Select the desired payment category from the drop down.
 - Fill in the challan with required information as asked for or select from the drop down options whenever available. Take adequate care while filling in (a) Name (b) Date of Birth & (c) Mobile Number as asked for in the lower part of the screen. This information is important to reprint the e-Receipt subsequent to any successful payment.
 - Once required data is filled in click on 'Submit'.
 - Te system will ask you to verify the details entered and confirm the transaction in the next page. Verify the details and click on **'Confirm'**.
 - The system will request you to select the desired **payment mode** from various options. Please note that the bank charges for various payment modes are also displayed which is to be borne by the remitter. **Carefully examine the charges displayed since the charges for different payment mode are different.** Select the desired payment mode.
 - Now the system will guide the remitter through the payment process. Once the payment is completed successfully on e-Receipt is generated containing a **Reference Number** in PDF format. Take a print out. You may also save this optionally for future reference. The e-Receipt can also be regenerated/reprinted afterwards from 'Payment History' link of 'State Bank Collect'.

(2) If 'SBI branch is selected as payment mode a Pre Acknowledgement Payment (PAP) form is generated which contains the relevant details for payment at Branch. The payer takes the print out of the PAP Form and visits any SBI branch for payment through Cash or cheque drawn on SBI Branch. After the payment is successfully processed by the branch, the branch will give an acknowledgement of payment on the PAP Form. Now any time the payer may optionally return to 'State Bank Collect' link in the home page of www.onlinesbi.com for printing the e-Receipt from the 'Payment History' link.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

All the originals documents and the information supplied by the students regarding their qualifications, etc. will be verified by appropriate authority. In case the documents and information submitted are found to be false at any time, the admission into the course will be cancelled and the amount deposited at the time of admission shall be forfeited by the University.

The decision of the Director, DEC, Berhampur University in all matters relating to admission, academic programmes, etc. shall be final.

The D.E.C. is not responsible for any postal delay or misplacement. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Eligible applicants will be admitted to the course. Failure to produce any document shall disqualify an applicant from taking admission. All original documents (including SLC/CLC/TC and Conduct Certificate) will be returned to the candidates soon after spot admission is over on the same day. Admission into the course shall be as per the Rules of Admission of Berhampur University and in conformity with the minimum standard of instructions prescribed by the University Grants Commission as amended from time to time. The student will have the freedom to choose subjects only from the list of subjects/streams prescribed by the Distance Education Centre.

All admissions are provisional which can be cancelled at any time by the Centre for any valid reason such as misconduct, forgery, etc.

EXAMINATION CENTRES

The candidates are required to indicate the names of two colleges near their residence in the Application Form, which may be considered for allotting Examination Centres to them. However, candidates shall have to appear the examination from a centre as allotted to them by the Controller of Examinations, Berhampur University in consultation with the Director, DEC depending upon the availability of requisite infrastructure in a College/Institution.

MODE OF PAYMENT

All payment shall be made in the procedure/direction specified in Schedule C.

IDENTITY CARD

Each admitted candidate will be issued with an **Identity Card** by the Distance Education Centre. The candidates shall have to produce the Identity Card at various academic programmes and examination centres. Candidates are required to preserve the Identity Card carefully. This will prove their identity on any matter connected with the DEC. In case of loss of the card, a duplicate can be issued on application and payment of Rs.50/- (Rupees fifty) only. The payment of Rs.50/- (Rupees fifty) only will be made as per the mode specified in **Schedule C**.

CONTACT PROGRAMME

The DEC is planning to conduct theory Contact Programmes for Arts/ Science/ Commerce at Lingaraj Law College, Berhampur and some other colleges, depending on feasibility during the academic year 2016-17. Contact classes for a paper carrying 100 marks will be held if the student's strength in that paper exceeds twenty-five. The teachers of the particular discipline of the contact programme will provide classroom instructions, guidance and counselling on the course/subjects. Students are required to attend the classes at their own cost. If the enrolment of students in a particular subject is less than 25, no contact classes will be conducted for such subject(s).

<u>The Contact Classes for 1st Year students of Science & Commerce are fixed to be held at</u> Lingaraj Law College, Berhampur during the month of February and March. Students are required to attend the classes as per the Time Table notified by the college centre. For Arts contact programme, centre will be notified in the University Website in due couse of time

For the B. Sc. (Hons.) students, the DEC is planning to conduct Practical Contact Programmes in all papers excluding the electives and Mathematics in some affiliated colleges of Berhampur University depending on number of students admitted during the year from a region. The venue & date for practical contact programmes will be intimated to the students in due course of time.

The Practical examinations of B.Sc. students will be held immediately after the completion of the practical contact programmes in the same college where contact programmes are conducted. Students are advised to attend the practical contact programmes and appear the practical examinations in the same college positively because for DE Mode students, no other practical examinations will be conducted after the theory examinations. The Principals/ the C.O.E., BU will notify the dates of practical examinations during the contact programmes.

N.B. Schedules of Contact Programmes of different subjects will be uploaded in the University website after getting it from the Core Resource Person. Student are required to watch the University website (<u>www.buodisha.edu.in</u>)

UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS

The University Examinations for the students of DE mode shall be the same as for the college students. The date and time of examination shall be determined by the Controller of Examinations. Information regarding centres of examination, and other instructions shall be sent to the student course. Candidates admitted into the Three Year Degree Course (B.A./B.Com./B.Sc. (H)) during 2016 - 2019 shall have to appear at the University Examination at the end of each academic session. Examination Time Table and other instructions will be uploaded in the University website.

MARK SHEET AND PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE

After publication of the results the Mark Sheet and Provisional Certificate will be sent to the students by **<u>Regd. Post / Speed Post</u>**.

INTERNSHIP AND PRACTICAL PROGRAMME

Adequate number of Practical and Internship Programmes wherever applicable will be conducted, as per the requirement under intimation to the concerned students. Students are required to undergo the programmes at their OWN COST.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS

In the event of change of address the students are required to get mailing list changed on application and payment of Rs.50/- (Rupees fifty)only as per the procedure/mode as specified in Schedule C

CHANGE OF SUBJECT(S)

A student admitted with a particular subject(s) or combination of subjects of a stream may be permitted by the Director to change once his/her subject(s) or combination of subject(s) within 30 (thirty) days from the last date of admission into First Year Course on payment of Rs.100/- (Rupees one hundred) only. No student shall be permitted to change his/her subject(s) or combination of subject(s) thereafter. The mode of payment will be made as per the procedure/mode as specified in **Schedule C**.

ENROLMENT NUMBER

Each student will be assigned an Enrolment Number on admission. In all communications addressed to the DEC this number should be quoted. Letters received without the enrolment number will not be attended to.

N.B: Besides Compulsory Papers, a B. Sc. (Hons.) student shall take an Honours subject carrying 800 marks, one Pass subject carrying 400 marks, one Minor Elective carrying 100 marks and one Major Elective carrying 200 marks consisting of two papers each carrying 100 marks as mentioned in the above table.

In Pass Subjects(s) with Practical shall carry 75% theory and 25% Practical.

In Honours subjects having practical components, Paper-V and Paper-VIII are Practicals of 100 marks each.

No student shall be allowed to take Mathematics without studying this subject at the Higher Secondary level (+2 level).

The B.Sc. Honours students have to attend practical classes in their Honours/ Pass subjects (except Mathematics) in 2^{nd} & Final Year. They have to prepare records which shall be inspected by both the internal and external examiners who shall take those into consideration to determine the results of the practical examination. The Practical examinations will be held immediately after the completion of practical contact classes in the same college. The dates of the examinations will be notified by the Principal of the College/ the Controller of Examinations, Berhampur University.

EDUCATION PRACTICE/TEACHING/PROJECT WORK/PRACTICAL

The students having Education as a subject either as General (Pass) or Honours shall have to attend the practice teaching programme and deliver 30 lessons (15 in each of the two method subjects). The programme will be held centrally at Berhampur. The date and venue of the programme will be intimated to them separately. There will be a practical examination for them in Education. This will be conducted centrally at Berhampur or as fixed by the Controller of Examinations of the University. **They will have to attend both the practice teaching programme and practical examination at their own cost.**

The student who fails to undertake the practice teaching and project work on the scheduled date shall have to intimate the DEC Office whose case may be considered in the subsequent academic session. No programme will be conducted separately in the middle of the session.
