Admission Procedure & Schedule

1. Last date of submission of application will be
In case sufficient applications are not received to fill up the seats, up to the last date, the last date may be extended, if deemed necessary. However, no admission will be made beyond the cutoff date prescribed by the Apex Regulatory Body, if any.
2. The admissions in the University shall be made strictly on the basis of merit:
Provided that for the purpose of filling minority quota in the University established and administered by a minority community, the zone of consideration for determination of merit shall be limited only to the students belonging to the minority community.
3. Merit for admission in the University may be determined either on the basis of marks or grade obtained in the qualifying examination and achievements in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities or on the basis of marks or grade obtained in the entrance test conducted at the State Level either by an Association of the Universities conducting similar courses or by

any agency of the State: Provided that admission in professional and technical courses shall be made through an entrance test, if the number of applicants is more than Tri-times of the sanctioned seats in a particular course.

4. The detail of Entrance test, wherever necessary, and the counseling for admission will be made available on the University Website.
5. In case sufficient applications are not received in a course, the applicant will be given option to change to any other course in the university, subject to the eligibility and merit or for the refund of fee.

Note :-

1. **The Fee will be charged in Two installments. First installment will be paid by the student at the time of admission and second installment in the January as per the schedule notified separately.**
2. **One time admission charges will be extra at the time of admission; Rs. 2500/- In the case of B.A./B.Sc./ B.Com./ B.Lib / B.B.A./B.C.A. and Rs. 5000/- in case of M.A./M.Sc./M.Com./M.Lib./MBA/MCA Courses. Admission charges for Professional Diploma/ Graduate Courses will be 5000/- and MPT, M.Tech and LL.M. will be 10,000/- and Ph.D. Rs 25,000/- . The Examination fee, Red Cross Fee(Rs. 60/-), Magazine Subscription(Rs. 250/-) and Hostel Charges will also be charged extra. No admission charges will be taken from the students of Shastri /Acharya/M.A. Sanskrit. The Admission Fee, Red Cross Fee and Magazine Fee will be deposited by the students in the bank in a separate account of University.**
2. **Number of seats shall be at the discretion of the University with the approval of the competent Authority/Apex Body, if any.**
3. **SC/ST Candidates will be given 5% relaxation in marks obtained in the qualifying examination. However, this will not go below the pass marks.**
4. **Fee Structure may be reviewed on year to year basis.**
5. **For admission to B.A./B.Sc/B.Com./BBA and BCA courses:**
 - i) **A candidate who is placed in compartment in one subject only in 10+2 examination of the Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani or of any other equivalent Board/University recognized by this University may be allowed admission provisionally in 1st semester.**
 - ii) **Such a candidate must clear the compartment in two consecutive chances. If he /she fails to produce/submit the proof of having passed the compartment subject even at the second chance to be held simultaneously with TDC-2nd semester examination, his/her result for the TDC - 1st & 2nd semester examination shall stand automatically cancelled.**

The environment is fully conducive and inviting for study and learning. Library learning resources both Print as well as electronic resources of BMU Central Library will be enriched in all disciplines. Internet Connection with a bandwidth of 8Mbps will be provided to the BMU Library and 10 PC's of latest configuration will be installed in the library for e-learning, and research. User education/Information literacy programmes will be organized regularly to train library users to access and use e-information resources. All the functions and activities of the University Library will be fully automated and modernized on the basis of national and international standards.

A computer Lab will be established in Library Science Dept. so as to train the students and research scholars in information handling activities. University Library will work not only as a knowledge resource centre but also a laboratory for experiments and learning for library scientists and budding library professionals. Resources of University Library and Library Science Dept. will be supplemented and complimented with internet based services and online databases and other e-resources. Framework for quality assurance in library services of the University Library as well as maintenance of standards of library science education as per the requirements and guidelines of NAAC Bangalore (UGC) will be prepared and implemented.

- a) **Books shall be issued to the students for a period of 15 days. A fine of Rs. 50/- per day will be imposed if books are not returned on time.**
- b) **Students must present their identity card / library card while issuing books, journals and magazines.**
- c) **The students will obtain NOC before issuance of examination roll number and final clearance.**

Hospitals

The Campus has a famous Eye Hospital, started in 1948. The hospital is extending wonderful job for the people of Northern India. Every year around 1,00,000 patients are being treated free of cost. The hospital is having state-of-art gadgets and equipments. The capacity of the hospital is 250 beds. The campus is known for the services offered by the Hospital to the people of area.

There is also General Hospital attached to SBMN Ayurvedic College, providing free of cost treatment to the

patients of nearby area and the students of the University. In the Ayurvedic General Hospital, PANCHKARMA is a purificatory and rejuvenating therapy. It deals with five types of Karma i.e. Vamana, Virechana, Basti which is of two types Anuvasana and Niruha and finally Nasya. It also includes Raktamokshana. Snehana and Swaedena are the pre-purificatory therapies i.e. the procedure which is done before the above said panchkarma therapies.

There is Dental hospital which was started in 1997. It has 121 dental chairs with all accessories. It has also the most important dental equipment like RVG and OPG. Now the Dental OPD is about 100 patients per day.

The University has Physiotherapy Hospital also, having the facilities for treatment of all types of pains, disabilities and injuries like sports injury, musculoskeletal injuries, nerve related injuries like hemiplegia, diplegia, quadriplegia and nerve damage etc and birth related anomalies. Physiotherapy is an ultra modern technique to promote mobility, function, impairment and quality of life by using Physical methods like exercise, mobilization, manipulation, pressure, temperature (hot or cold), vibration, electric stimulus etc. The hospital consists of different department like Neuro-rehabilitation, Sports-training, Gymnasium, General Rehabilitation, Electrotherapy, Exercise Therapy etc. The hospital has state-of-the-art equipment for physiotherapeutic treatment. Normal OPD of the Physiotherapy Hospital is 200 patients per day.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Refund / Cancellation Policy

All requests for cancellation / withdrawal of admission must be made in writing well in time before the last date of admission along with the original fee receipt quoting the course/ branch in which admission was granted, Entrance test / AIEEE Roll No. & Rank, wherever applicable. Requests made verbally or by fax/ email or without the original fee receipt shall not be entertained.

In case of Refund of fee admissible under the rule deduction of fee will be as under:

Note: In case a candidate seeks admission after 31st August, no fee/charges will be refunded to him. Fee will also not be refunded in case the admission of the student is cancelled on the basis of the documents submitted by him/her, not being found in order at any stage

2. Anti-ragging Drive/Zero Tolerance Policy

Ragging, its abetment, eve-teasing and / or any kind of mental or physical harassment, either directly or indirectly, of any students by whatsoever name called may hurt the sensibilities or self esteem of student(s), inside or outside the University and/or its hostel(s) / mess, cafeteria is strictly prohibited by law as held by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide its order dated 08/05/2009 in the case titled "University of Kerala Vs Council, Principal's College Kerala & others" bearing CA No. 887/2009. Disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act, which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student(s) or asking the students to do any act or raise fear or apprehension there of is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in fresher or junior students or asking the students to do any act or perform something, which such students will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of fresher or a junior student shall constitute an act of ragging.

Association, active or passive, with any unlawful organization including holding and/ or participating in demonstrations, inciting violence, displaying notices or circulating handbills in the University and/ or its hostel (s)/ mess are strictly prohibited.

Smoking, consumption of alcohol, drugs or any other intoxicant by whatsoever name called within the University premises and/ or its Hostel(s) is strictly prohibited.

Any student carrying a fire arm or any dangerous weapon in and around the University premises and / or its hostel(s) shall be suspended forthwith and expelled from the University.

Besides police/ legal action, a student found indulging in any of the above activities shall be expelled from the University. In case of expulsion from the University, under such circumstances, the student's tuition, development and / or any other fee paid by him/ her shall stand forfeited.

3. The students are required to observe the following rules during their stay on the Campus:-

- a) Students should have to switch off their mobile phones before entering the class-room, library and labs. otherwise it will be confiscated.
- b) Candidates failing to deposit dues within prescribed time will have to deposit a fine of Rs. 100/- per day upto a period of seven days and, thereafter, with Rs. 500/- per day fine upto another seven days after which the name will be automatically struck off from the class. However, re-admission may be allowed in special circumstances by the competent authority on payment of Rs.5000/- as re-admission fees.
- c) All admissions are provisional subject to verification of documents and approvals by the competent authorities.
- d) The candidates can download the Admission form from the website "www.babamastnathuniversity.com". Such candidates will submit the admission form alongwith the bank draft of Rs. 1000/- in favour of Baba Mastnath University, Asthal Bohar (Rohtak) to the Assistant Registrar (Academic), Baba Mastnath University, Asthal Bohar, Rohtak in person or by registered post.
- e) Students of all courses should be regular in attending classes. 75% attendance is minimally required in each subject(Theory/Practical, wherever applicable, separately) to appear in the respective examination. Student falling short of attendance will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- f) All students will appear in assignments, seminars and presentations. Absence from the tests or any delay in the submission of assignment/presentations will automatically lead to punishment as per rules.
- g) The outlines of the courses have been made available on the University website.
- h) All students have to come in their proper prescribed uniform every day otherwise punishment will be given as per Instructions of Uniform Committee.

4. Students Discipline

The detailed rules on discipline of students have been given on University website.

5. Hostel Rules

- a) Hostel door will be opened in morning at 5.00 AM and closed in night at 10.00 PM. Before and after this time, permission will be taken from the Hostel Warden.
- b) All hostlers should seek prior permission of hostel warden for going home or to relative's / guardian's house.
- c) Use of alcohol and intoxicants of any nature are strictly prohibited. If any student is found guilty, strict disciplinary action including fine or cancellation of admission will be taken.
- d) Students are advised not to keep excessive cash or valuables with them in the hostel.
- e) Students leaving for home must obtain the outward pass duly authorized by warden and get it signed from their parents, which will be checked on their arrival.
- f) Detailed rules in this regard have been made available on the University website.

6. Limited Liability

All admissions made by the Admission Committee are provisional and subject to confirmation by the University. If the admission of any candidate(s) is not confirmed by the University, for any reason whatsoever, liability of the University will be limited only to the refund of full fee paid by the candidate and that there shall be no further consequent liability on the University and / Or any of its employee(s).

In case a candidate seeks admission on producing the forged document or fraudulently, his admission shall be cancelled forthwith and fee will be confiscated. Further legal action will be taken against him/her as per rules.

7. Jurisdiction

Disputes, if any, arising out of this Admission Policy & Selection Procedure shall be the subject matter of Rohtak Courts only.
